### ORDINANCE NO. O-997-004

## AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING NON-MOTORIZED TRAVEL UPON THE E-470 PUBLIC HIGHWAY IN THE UNINCORPORATED PORTIONS OF DOUGLAS COUNTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 42-4-1010(3), C.R.S., the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas is authorized to prohibit by ordinance all forms of non-motorized travel, including but not limited to pedestrian, bicycle, animal rider and animal-drawn conveyance travel, upon that portion of the E-470 Public Highway which passes through the unincorporated area of Douglas County; and

**WHEREAS**, the E-470 Public Highway Authority has requested that the Board of County Commissioners adopt such an ordinance, prohibiting non-motorized travel upon the E-470 Public Highway within the jurisdictional boundaries of Douglas County; and

**WHEREAS,** the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Douglas finds that non-motorized travel upon the E-470 Public Highway is dangerous and incompatible with the normal and safe movement of traffic upon the E-470 Public Highway and that the prohibition of non-motorized travel upon the E-470 Public Highway is necessary to promote public safety; now, therefore,

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF DOUGLAS, COLORADO as follows:

- All forms of non-motorized travel, including but not limited to pedestrian, bicycle, animal rider and animal-drawn conveyance travel shall be prohibited at all times on those portions of the E-470 Public Highway which pass through the unincorporated areas of Douglas County, Colorado.
- Any person who violates this ordinance commits a class A traffic infraction under section 42-4-1010(4), C.R.S., and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$15.00 nor more than \$100.00 for each separate violation.
- Section 3. Pedestrian, bicycle, animal rider, and animal-drawn conveyance travel on the E-470 Public Highway would create a dangerous condition on the highway.

  Therefore, this ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection of the public safety and welfare and shall be effective on the date of its adoption.
