# General Sanitizers and Disinfectants

#### How to know if they are approved:

- Must have an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) registration number.
- Must be registered with Colorado Department of Agriculture (CDA).
- Use the <u>National Pesticide</u> <u>Information Retrieval System</u> to check both EPA and CDA registrations.
- Follow all label instructions especially concentration, contact time, method, and surfaces.



## **For Sanitizers**

- The label says to use on food contact surfaces.
- The label does not say to rinse after use.

## **For Disinfectants**

- The label says to use in hospitals
- The label says it is effective for Salmonella choleraesuis (enteric), Staphylococcus aureus, and Pseudomonas aeruginosa
